

## Foolhardy Circus Home-Ed Camp - Full Terms & Conditions

### **The Sensible Stuff:**

- ◆ Full address is on the webpage and on the email ticket confirmation you will receive from our bookings site.
- ◆ Camping isn't compulsory – you can come and go each day if you prefer.
- ◆ Everyone should attend the Welcome Meeting at 1.30pm on the Wednesday, to get vital info for the week ahead and to meet staff and crew, and the other participants.
- ◆ Quiet between 11pm and 7am please
- ◆ No dogs please, unless by prior arrangement, and even then, it will need to be a service dog.
- ◆ Please keep our site tidy! Use the bin bags and the bins/skip provided. The skip contents are fully recycled.
- ◆ Mains water is available for drinking, washing and cooking, and there is a hot shower too. Please conserve water.
- ◆ Treat the toilets & shower well - leave them as you wish to find them. Bring a loo roll and don't forget a torch!
- ◆ This is basic camping so there are no electric hook-ups available. Solar panels very welcome. Cars will be parked at the top end of the field after emptying your gear on your chosen pitch, only a minutes' walk away.

### **The Serious Stuff:**

- ◆ No camp fires in the camping areas. Gas BBQ's are fine. We'll have a big campfire for all to enjoy safely.
- ◆ Adults are responsible for their own children. This is a child friendly event and whilst we are fully trained in circus skills, have worked with children for donkey's years, are very safety conscious and are fully insured, we are also aware that accidents do happen. This event is not a crèche facility and so you need to be aware of where your child is and what they are up to at all times.
- ◆ We will have first aiders on site, but please bring your own basic first aid kit for camping.
- ◆ Anyone continually messing around, causing disruption or treating circus equipment, staff or other people inappropriately, may be asked to leave, at our discretion.
- ◆ 100% no drugs on site and whilst we are happy for over 18's to bring alcohol we must stress that moderation is the order of the day. Anyone found drunk will be asked to leave. There is no bar on site.
- ◆ **Cancellations:** In the event that you need to cancel, tickets are refundable ONLY IF we are able to re-allocate your places. We will do our best to do so, but this may not be possible for late cancellations. An admin fee of £5 will be deducted from any refund.
- ◆ If the weather turns monsoon-like and the fields turn boggy before the event we'll be in touch to postpone it.

### **The Fun Stuff:**

- ◆ If you'd like to help out please let us know. We love volunteers!
- ◆ Bring flags, windsocks, wind chimes & pretty things to make the site beautiful – please take them home again.
- ◆ Bring circus/clown/acrobatic costumes to wear in the final Big Top show if your child/ren plan to take part.
- ◆ Bring acoustic musical instruments to play around the camp fire.
- ◆ Fire skills welcome in the evenings, but please liaise with us as we'll mark out a safe area for you.
- ◆ Bring balloons, bubbles, crazy costumes for the disco...
- ◆ Come prepared for the talent show! Everyone is welcome to strut their funky stuff, doing anything that you feel you want to share, not just circus related... keep it clean though ;- ) Aim at around 1-2 minutes or less.
- ◆ Free teas and coffee all week in the info tent – but do bring any speciality milks or teas/coffees/hot chocs, whether for yourself, or to share, as well as your own mug. Circus Camp mugs are available to buy. *Contributions of biscuits, teabags, milk etc. to share are v welcome as always – please drop them off when you arrive.*
- ◆ We welcome spontaneous happenings – perhaps an organised game of hide n seek (adults too!), or a game of footie, or hair braiding, face painting, or an offer of massages... or... whatever you wish. There will be a notice board up in the info tent for you to promote your happening.
- ◆ Feel free to promote any home-ed stuff you are involved in, once again in the info tent.
- ◆ We have a pop-up workshop space again this year for anyone to use to offer any workshop they feel might be fun, either aimed at the children or the adults. Speak to us beforehand via email, or when you arrive, and bring along anything you may need for the workshop.
- ◆ Bring along anything you want to sell in our flea market on the Thursday. We all love a bargain! No fee to sell.
- ◆ We will have some circus equipment on sale during the event, but if you want something more specialist and you wish to collect it at the event, please get in touch asap and we'll give you a quote.
- ◆ T-shirts only available to purchase in advance via the booking form.
